3. The following portion of Paragraph 1.9 of Instructions to Bidders Data Sheet ,

“The procurement shall be limited to local consultants”

shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

“The procurement is open to local and international consultants”


4. The following portion of Paragraph 3.7 of Instructions to Bidders Data Sheet ,

“Local Consultants must include a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC). Proposals without a valid TCC will not be accepted.”

shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

“All resident/Jamaican based Consultants are required to present a valid Tax Compliance Letter (“TCL”) or a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (“TCC”) issued by the Jamaican tax authorities with its Technical Proposal. Proposals without a valid TCC or TCL will not be accepted. For non-resident/overseas-based Consultants, a valid TCL or TCC will be required prior to execution of the Contract.”
